


The Catholic Kids Bulletins downloads contain bulletins for all Sunday Masses and Holy Days of Obligation for diocese in the United States. If you live in an area with a Holy Day of Obligation that isn't included, please email me at catholickidsbulletin@outlook.com and I'll try to make it available in future downloads.

Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God is a Holy Day of Obligation that is abrogated this year, but the bulletin is included if you plan to attend Mass.

Ascension (5/9/24) is listed without a date because most diocese move that feast to a Sunday; however, there are a few diocese in which it is a day of obligation. I left it without a date so you could use it on the Thursday or Sunday without your children telling you that the date is wrong.

Some days, such as Ash Wednesday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday aren't Holy Days of Obligation, but they are included in the download.

During Lent, there are Sundays (3rd, 4th, and 5th) in which churches can use either the Year B readings or the Year A Scrutinies. Both are included and labeled on the lower left hand corner.










Jesus told the disciples that He will come back to earth!







Saint Francis Xavier traveled all over the world taking care of the poor and teaching about Jesus.





because Jesus is coming.






Year B: Third Sunday of Advent




Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.






We are finally singing Christmas Carols! During Advent, we didn't sing Christmas songs because we were still waiting for Jesus.



Feast of the Holy Family


Today is the Feast of the Holy Family. We celebrate Jesus' family and our families! Thank God for your family.
