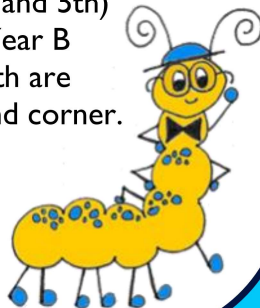
The Catholic Kids Bulletins downloads contain bulletins for all Sunday Masses and Holy Days of Obligation for diocese in the United States. If you live in an area with a Holy Day of Obligation that isn't included, please email me at [catholickidsbulletin@outlook.com](mailto:catholickidsbulletin@outlook.com) and I'll try to make it available in future downloads.

Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God is a Holy Day of Obligation that is abrogated this year, but the bulletin is included if you plan to attend Mass.

Ascension (5/9/24) is listed without a date because most diocese move that feast to a Sunday; however, there are a few diocese in which it is a day of obligation. I left it without a date so you could use it on the Thursday or Sunday without your children telling you that the date is wrong.

Some days, such as Ash Wednesday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday aren't Holy Days of Obligation, but they are included in the download.

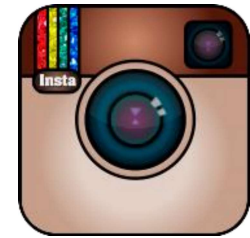
